




THE NEW SESSION KICKS OFF AT SHEMFORD FUTURISTIC SCHOOL!



This activity aims to express the human digestive system's role in food digestion and importance of digestion.







SEA Grade VIII

Hands-on activity is the best learning








SEA Grade IX


Social Science Week



Child Łabour

Child labour refers to the employment of children in any work that deprives them of their childhood, interferes with their ability to attend regular school, and that is mentally, physically, socially or morally dangerous and harmful. In villages, it is a common sight to see children of poor families working in fields or elsewhere to contribute to the family income. Such children are deprived of opportunities of education and are also prone to health risks.

In a sense, child labour is open exploitation as it deprives children of education and pushes them into exploitative situations. The side-effects of working at a young age are: risks of contracting occupational diseases like skin diseases, diseases of the lungs, weak eyesight, TB etc.; vulnerability to sexual exploitation at the workplace; deprived of education. They grow up unable to avail development opportunities and end up as unskilled workers for the rest of their lives.

According to Article 23 of the Indian Constitution any type of forced labour is prohibited. Article 24 states that a child under 14 years cannot be employed to perform any hazardous work. Similarly, Article 39 states that "the health and strength of workers, men and women, and the tender age of children are not abused". In the same manner, Child Labour Act (Prohibition and Regulation) 1986 prohibits children under the age of 14 years to be working in hazardous industries and processes. Child Labour (Prohibition & Regulation) Amendment Act 2016 prohibits the employment of Children below 14 years in all employment and with the provisions for prohibition on employment of adolescents (14-18 Years) in the scheduled hazardous occupations and processes.

ہر مذہب ہمیں یہ بتاتا ہے کہ اچھے انسان اس مٹی سے پیار کرتے ہیں جس میں انہوں نے جنم لیا ہوتا ہے۔ <mark>جن کھیتوں، گلیوں،</mark> محلوں میں وہ کھیل کود کر پروان چڑھتے ہوتے ہیں اس علاقہ سے اس دیش سے پیار کرتے ہیں۔جب کسی دیش کے لوگ آپس میں پیار محبت سے رہتے ہیں تو دوسرے دیشوں کے لوگ ان کی طرف آنکھ اٹھا کر بھی نہیں دیکھ سکتے اور <mark>جس دیش کے</mark> لوگ قوم، مذہب، ذات، برادری، نسل، علاقہ اور زبان کے نام پر آپس میں لڑتے ہیں اتفاق کی بجائے نفاق کے راستے پر چلتے ہیں۔ دوسرے دیشوں کے لوگ ان سے بالکل نہیں ڈرتے اور اکثر ایسا ہوتا ہے کہ غیر آکر انہیں غلام بنا لیتے ہیں۔

ہندوستان کے لوگ آپس میں لڑتے جھگڑتے رہتے تھے۔ وہ برادری، نسل، مذہب، رنگ اور زبان کی بنا پر ایک دوسرے سے نفرت کرتے تھے تو اس کا فائدہ انگریزوں نے اٹھایا اور اپنی چالاکی کے ساتھ یہاں کے رہنے والوں میں نفرت کی دیوا<mark>ریں کھڑی کر کے</mark> آہستہ آہستہ ہمارے ہندوستان پر قبضہ کر لیا۔وہ لڑاؤ اور راج کرو کی پالیسی پر چلتے ہوئے ہمیں لوٹتے رہے اور ہمارا خون چوستے رہے۔ اگر سب ہندوستانی اپنے آپ کو ایک دوسرے کے سگے سمجھتے تو ہندوستان نے غلام نہیں ہونا تھا اور اس وقت

ہندوستان دنیا کی عظیم ترین طاقت ہوتا۔ مگر افسوس ہے کہ اتنے سالوں کی غلامی کے بعد بھی ہمیں <mark>عق</mark>ل نہیں <mark>آئی۔ آج ہندوست</mark>ان کا کوئی بھی اخبار اٹھا کر دیکھیں تو ایک آدھ خبر دو گروپوں کے تصادم کی ضرور نظر آئے گی۔ کہیں ہندوؤں اور مسلمانوں کے درمیان فساد ہوا ہوتا ہے تو کسی خبر میں <mark>شیعہ اور</mark> سنی مسلمانوں کے فساد کی تفصیل درج ہوتی ہے۔ کسی روز اخبار میں یہ خبر آجاتی ہے کہ فلاں گاؤں کے لوگوں نے آپس میں ایک دوسرے پر حملہ کر دی<mark>ا ہے۔ کسی جگہ جاٹ غیر جاٹ کی لڑائی کا ذکر ہوتا ہے۔ حصہ کوتاہ ہندو مسلم، مسلم مسلم، ہندو ہریجن اور ہندو ہندو فسادات کی خبریں ہر روز اخباروں کی کی ڈبریں ہر روز اخباروں کی علامی کے بعد بھی ہم نے کچھ نہیں سیکھا۔</mark>

دنیا ترقی کے میدان میں بہت آگے نکل گئی ہے مگر ہم ابھی تک جنگل کی تہذیب میں ہی گھوم رہے ہیں۔تہذیب یافتہ قومیں آپس میں نہیں لڑا کرتی۔ ان میں لاکھ اختلاف بھی کیوں نہ ہوں وہ آپسی بات چیت سے آپسی مسئلے حل کرتی ہیں۔ مگر ہندوستان کا باوا آدم ہی نرالا ہے۔ یہاں کوئی بھی واقعہ یا حادثہ ہوجائے اسے بنیاد بنا کر فرقہ وارانہ فساد شروع ہو جاتے ہیں اور جگ میں ہماری جگ سنائی ہوتی ہے۔

یہ فساد کون کرتا ہے؟ ظاہر ہے کہ شریف لوگ ایسا <mark>کام نہیں کرت</mark>ے انہیں تو اپنی روزی کا فکر ہوتا ہے۔ ایسے فسادات میں نقصان بھی شریف آدمیوں اور مزدوروں کا ہی ہوتا ہے۔ <mark>سرمایہ دار ا</mark>پنا سرمایہ بڑھانے کی فکر میں رہتے ہیں۔تو پھر آپسی ٹکراؤ کون کراتے ہیں۔ یہ فساد کرانے والے لوگ سیاستدان ہ<mark>وتے ہیں۔یہ اپنے</mark> مفاد کی خاطر اپنی لیڈرشپ کی خاطر انسانی خون بہانے سے گریز نہیں کرتے۔ ان کی مدد وہ فرقہ پرست اخبارات کرتے ہیں جو اپنی بکری بڑھانے کے لئے ایسے واقعات کو خوب نمک مرچ لگا کر اچھالتے ہیں اور اپنے کالم میں ایک دوسرے فرقہ کے خلاف لکھ کر اپنا فائدہ حاصل کرنا چاہتے ہیں۔

بہت کم اخباریں ایسی ہیں جنہیں قوم پرست کہا ج<mark>اسکتا</mark> ہے <mark>اور جو</mark> ایسے فسادات کی مخالف<mark>ت کرتی ہی</mark>ں۔ اسی طرح بہت کم سیاستدان ایسے ہیں جو دل کی گہرائیوں سے چاہتے ہیں کہ سارے ہن<mark>دوستانی بھ</mark>ائی بھائی بن کر رہیں۔

سب ہندوستانیوں کو یہ سمجھ لینا چاہئے کہ اگر ہم میں اتفاق رہا تو ہمارا دیش ترقی کرجائے گا۔بلیک کرنے والے بلیک نہیں کرسکیں گے، ذخیرہ اندوزی نہیں ہوگی، دھوکہ بازی اور رشوت کا بازار س<mark>رد پڑ جائے</mark> گا۔ اتفاق کی برکت سے ہمارے بہت سے مسائل بھی حل ہو جائیں گے، دیش ترقی کے راستے پر گامزن ہوگا اور اگر ن<mark>فاق ہوا تو</mark> نہ صرف ہماری ترقی ہی رک جائے گی بلکہ ہوجائے گا۔

جب جب بھی ہندوستان میں نفاق ہوا ہے تب تب ہی ہم پر مصیبتیں ناز<mark>ل ہوئی ہیں۔</mark> اگر ہم تواریخ سے سبق حاصل کریں اور آپس میں مل جل کر رہنا سیکھیں تو نہ صرف ہمارے مسائل ہی جلد <mark>آسان ہو سکتے ہی</mark>ں بلکہ ہم خوشیوں بھری زندگی بھی گزار سکتے ہیں۔ تاریخ اور ادب کی کتابوں میں اتفاق کے بارے میں ڈھیر ساری کہانیاں ملتی ہیں۔ ہم انھیں ہر روز بروز پڑھتے -ہیں لیکن ان سے کوئی فائدہ حاصل نہیں کرتے

یہ کہانیاں ہمیں یہ سبق دیتی ہیں کہ اگر ہم اتفاق سے رہیں تو فائدہ میں رہیں گے اور نفاق کی بدولت ہم تباہ و برباد ہو جاتے ہیں۔نفاق کی بدولت ہم اپنے دشمن کا مقابلہ نہیں کرسکتے۔ یہ کہانی یہ سبق بھی دیتی ہے کہ دنیا میں کچھ لوگ ایسے بھی ہوتے ہیں جو ہمارا اتفاق دیکھ کر جلتے ہیں اور اپنی خود غرضی کی خاطر ہم میں نفاق پیدا کرتے ہیں۔ ہمیں ایسے لوگوں سے بچنا چاہئے۔ اور ہمارے سماج میں بھی جو ایسے لوگ ہیں ان سے خوب ہوشیار رہنا چاہئے کیونکہ یہ خود غرض لوگ اپنے فائدے کے چاہئے۔ اور ہمارے سماج میں بھی جو ایسے لوگ ہیں ان سے خوب ہوشیار رہنا چاہئے کیونکہ یہ خود غرض لوگ اپنے فائدے کے لیے دیش کی یکجہتی کو ختم کرتے ہیں۔ اسی طرح کچھ دیش بھی ایسے ہیں جو نہیں چاہتے کہ ہم ہندوستانی آپس میں پیار محبت سے رہیں۔ ہمیں ان دیشوں سے بھی ہوشیار رہنا ہوگا۔ بھارت کے ہندوؤں، مسلمانوں، سکھوں اور عیسائیوں کو آپس محبت سے رہیں۔ ہمیں اتفاق رکھنا چاہیے۔ اگر ہم ایسا نہیں کرتے تو ہمارا حشر بھی حکایت کے چار بیلوں جیسا ہوسکتا ہے۔
